Farmville, September March 20

The **Woodland Community Center** (434-392-6106) is located at **103 Varner Drive** in Farmville (23901).

From Lynchburg and Points West:

Follow U.S. 460 East to the first Farmville exit on the right for U.S. 15 North/U.S. 460 Business East. Take the right hand turn just before the traffic light onto U.S. 460 Business East. Drive 2.5 miles and turn right on Agee Street (just before the Farmville Motel). Drive 0.2 miles to the main entrance.

From Charlottesville and Points North:

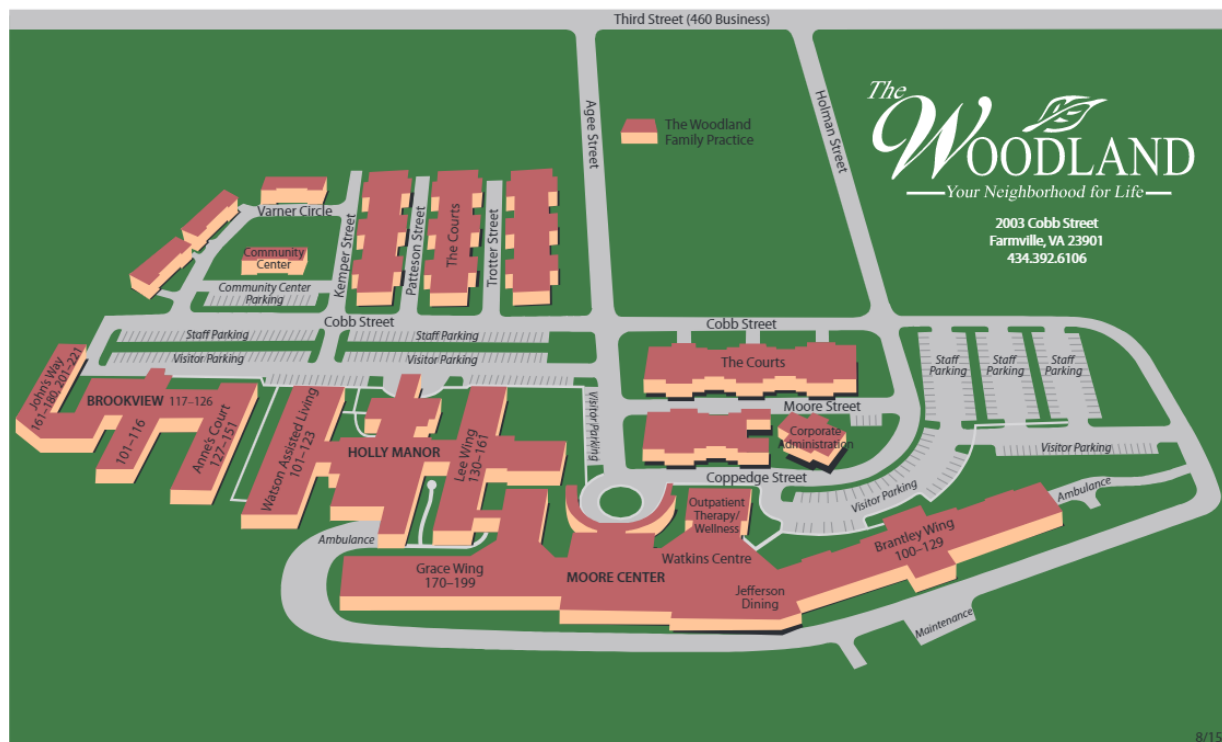
Take VA Route 20 South for roughly 37 miles and turn right at the traffic light onto U.S. 15 South. Follow U.S. 15 South for about 18 miles and take a left at the traffic light onto U.S. 460 Business East. Drive 2.5 miles and turn right on Agee Street (just before the Farmville Motel). Drive 0.2 miles to the main entrance.

From Richmond and Points East:

Take U.S. 360 West for roughly 30 miles. Then take the right exit for VA Route 307 West to Farmville. After about 10 miles merge onto U.S. 460 West. Go 4 miles then take the first Farmville exit on right for U.S. 460 Business West. Continue for 4 miles, through town, and turn left on Agee Street (just after the Farmville Motel). Drive 0.2 miles to the main entrance.

Suffolk, March 21

The **Suffolk Center for the Cultural Arts** is located at **110 W, Finney Avenue** in **Suffolk, VA 23434**.

There is plenty of free parking at the Center.

Directions from Newport News

Take I-664 S across the Monitor Merrimac Bridge Tunnel into Suffolk. Stay on I-664 South to Exit 13A, Rt. 58 toward Suffolk. Continue on Rt. 58. Exit Bus. Rt. 58 becomes Portsmouth Blvd/Constance Rd. Turn left at the sixth light onto Main Street. At the second light turn right to the Suffolk Center for Cultural Arts.

Directions from Portsmouth

Take 1-264 W through the Downtown tunnel towards Portsmouth/Suffolk. At the split, bear right toward I-664 Bowers Hill. Take Exit 13A, Rt. 58 toward Suffolk. Continue on Rt. 58. Exit Bus. Rt. 58 to Downtown Suffolk. Rt. 58 becomes Portsmouth Blvd/Constance Rd. Turn left at sixth light onto Main Street. At second light turn right to the Suffolk Center for Cultural Arts.

Culpeper, March 25

The **Best Western Hotel** is located at **791 Madison Road** in **Culpeper** (540 825-1263). There is plenty of free parking.

From the North: Take Route 66 West, then take route 29 South, exit 43-A, then forth Culpeper exit, Business Route 29.

From the South: Take Route 29 North, take the first Culpeper exit, Business Route 29.

From the East: Off interstate 95, Take Route 3 West to U.S. Route 29 South, take the second exit, Business Route 29.

From the West: Take Route 522 East, then turn right onto Main Street (US 15 Business, US 29 Business) and US 522 South). Go about 2.2 miles. Make a u-turn and hotel will be on your right.
