Farmville, March 23

The **Woodland Community Center** (434-392-6106) is located at **103 Varner Drive** in **Farmville, VA 23901**.

From Lynchburg and Points West:

Follow U.S. 460 East to the first Farmville exit on the right for U.S. 15 North/U.S. 460 Business East. Take the right hand turn just before the traffic light onto U.S. 460 Business East. Drive 2.5 miles and turn right on Agee Street (just before the Farmville Motel). Drive 0.2 miles to the main entrance.

From Charlottesville and Points North:

Take VA Route 20 South for roughly 37 miles and turn right at the traffic light onto U.S. 15 South. Follow U.S. 15 South for about 18 miles and take a left at the traffic light onto U.S. 460 Business East. Drive 2.5 miles and turn right on Agee Street (just before the Farmville Motel). Drive 0.2 miles to the main entrance.

From Richmond and Points East:

Take U.S. 360 West for roughly 30 miles. Then take the right exit for VA Route 307 West to Farmville. After about 10 miles merge onto U.S. 460 West. Go 4 miles then take the first Farmville exit on right for U.S. 460 Business West. Continue for 4 miles, through town, and turn left on Agee Street (just after the Farmville Motel). Drive 0.2 miles to the main entrance.

Wytheville, March 24

The **Wytheville Community Center** (866 694-8287 or direct 276 223-3416) is located at **333 Community Boulevard** in **Wytheville**, VA 24382.

From I-81 North (Bristol/Abingdon): Take Exit 72 to I-77 Exit 41

From I-81 South/I-77 North (Roanoke or Hillsville/Galax): Take Exit 72 to I-77 Exit 41

From I-77 South (Bluefield): Take Exit 41

Then, from all directions: Peppers Ferry Road to Community Boulevard, left turn in front of Comfort Suites.

Williamsburg, April 6

Legacy Hall is located at **4301 New Town Ave** in **Williamsburg**, VA 23188.

Parking available on the side of the road, or in a parking lot across from the building.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS FROM RICHMOND, VA

- Merge onto I-64 E via EXIT 75 toward Richmond Int'l Airport/Williamsburg/Norfolk
- Take the VA-199 E exit, EXIT 234, toward VA-646/Lightfoot. (go 0.25 miles)
- Merge onto VA-199 E. (go 6.04 miles)
- Take the exit toward VA-321/Monticello Ave. (go 0.14 miles)
- Merge onto VA-321 E/Monticello Ave via the ramp on the left toward Williamsburg. (go 0.57 miles)
- Turn left onto New Town Ave.
 - New Town Ave is 0.2 miles past Ironbound Rd
 - If you reach Courthouse St you've gone about 0.1 miles too far
- 4301 NEW TOWN AVE is on the left.
 - Your destination is just past Center St
 - If you reach Foundation St you've gone a little too

DRIVING DIRECTIONS FROM NORFOLK, VA

- Merge onto I-64 W toward Naval Base/Terminal Blvd. (go 35.96 miles)
- Merge onto VA-199 W via EXIT 242A toward Williamsburg/Jamestown. (go 6.95 miles)
- Take the exit toward VA-321/Monticello Ave. (go 0.14 miles)
- Merge onto Monticello Ave/VA-321 E. (go 0.51 miles)
- Turn left onto New Town Ave.
 - New Town Ave is 0.2 miles past Ironbound Rd
 - If you reach Courthouse St you've gone about 0.1 miles too far
- 4301 NEW TOWN AVE is on the left.
 - Your destination is just past Center St
 - If you reach Foundation St you've gone a little too far

Culpeper, April 7

The **Country Club of Culpeper** is located at **2100 Country Club Road** in **Culpeper VA, 22701**. (540 825-1746)

There is plenty of free parking.

From the North: Take Route 66 West, then take route 29 South, exit 43-A, then forth Culpeper exit, Business Route 29. Proceed 0.8 mile. Turn left onto Country Club Road. Proceed 0.3 mile. Turn right. Club will be on the left.

From the South: Take Route 29 North, take the first Culpeper exit, Business Route 29. Proceed 1.2 miles. Turn left onto Country Club Road. Proceed 0.3 mile. Turn right. Club will be on the left.
